Discussion	<p>The tree tunnel' road along Vicarage Lane was still too narrow due to slippage from the banks. Cllr Keen reported that she had contacted the relevant department but due to the cost of closing the road and actually doing the work it was unlikely to be done in the near future. She would carry on trying to get the work completed.</p> <p>The Butter St sign at the junction of Holt St was missing.</p> <p>Dog fouling had increased along Vicarage Lane and Park View Rise. Notices would be put on nearby infrastructure warning of possible fines for dog fouling.
