Discussion	<p>The annual safety report highlighted once again the wooden steps under the archway as unsafe. Quotes had been requested from three local firms.</p> <p>The report also mentioned cracking on the rubber surfaces but weather too wet to use this month.</p> <p>There was also a concern raised about a piece of the new equipment and the manufacturers would be contacted for their advice.</p> <p>Some signage was also out of date but had now been replaced.</p> <p>The electricity cabling was an issue at the moment because there was no power on.</p> <p>The new tables needed treating.</p> <p>Other minor issues could be sorted out by a working party in the spring.</p>

This was not urgent due to the reduction in nuisance motorbikes. Yale Home Security website had suitable cameras.</p> <p>The footpath behind the village hall was being used by nuisance motorbikes. Discussion	<p>The trees bordering St Mary's Close and Hillcroft, Vicarage Lane were still overgrown but DDC still haven't acted on the request to get this problem cleared. It was suggested that the PC wrote to Hillcroft and DDC advising them that the PC would get the trees cut back and charge them accordingly.</p> <p>The Village Hall was closed until at least January therefore PC meetings would continue via Zoom.</p> <p>The school was looking for a new Governor from the village, apply via the headmaster.</p> <p>The bus shelters were in need of tidying due to the increase in books etc. being left there.
