PUBLIC INPUT AND OTHER BUSINESS

Discussion	 The national hedgehog campaign was discussed which encourages residents to allow gaps in fencing for the free movement of hedgehogs. A pack is available for £150.00 but it was decided that as the parish is rural residents fences/hedges were probably good for hedgehogs. Cllr Tee will send to the school to see if it is of interest to them. Green Day was undertaken on 11th March and thanks were extended to Cllr Perrin for the maps. Election on 4th May 2023 is uncontested with four seats filled; Cllr Jarred, Cllr Delf, Cllr Perrin and Cllr Vurley. The remaining three seats will need to be co-opted after 9th May 2023. Annual and village meeting will be held on 23rd May 2023 which will have nibbles and wine. The "Welcome to Nonington" booklet will be updated once the new council is in position. Cllr Norton raised that Littlebourne have just erected a new speed sign on their welcome gates and wondered if the same could be placed in the village. The Clerk will investigate and report at the next meeting. Street light at end of village hall footpath is not working and is overgrown. Resident was encouraged to report to DDC and the Clerk will also to report and ask for vegetation to be cut
